### About

This low energy family house situated on the heights of Liège plays on urban local codes. The volume arises in the field which is characterized by a very steep slope. This slope is integrated inside the house. We revisit the typical "liegeoise" home reversing the program. The living room is located on the top floor while the bedrooms are located on the lower floors. In this way we optimize the views for each level. Light from the south side street enters the house via a glass staircase in front. Worked as a full-fledged space, it induces visual and spatial contacts between each floors. The bricks are imposed by the urban planning, we decided to play with it and to space out the brick to filter views from the street.
