These projects are the fruit of modernity revisited in each era by architects, from Art Nouveau to the present day: modest programmes or large-scale realisations, private commissions and public buildings. This volume is produced in partnership with the Faculty of Architecture, Architectural Engineering, Urban Planning LOCI of UCLouvain and the Faculty of Philosophy and Letters of UNamur (PaTHs), under the supervision of Jean-Paul Verleyen and Cécile Vandernoot. 
