At the initiative of Wallonia-Brussels International, the Museu Brasileiro da Escultura (MuBE) of Sao Paulo opens its space to three major exhibitions of Wallonia-Brussels concerning architecture (young architects), design (wood) and visual arts (Tapta).

The exhibition Dithyrambes, ReNouveaux Plaisir d'Architectures curated by the Belgian architect Pablo Lhoas (Professor at the Faculty of Architecture of La Cambre Horta - Université Libre de Bruxelles and founder of the office Lhoas & Lhoas) presents the work of nine emerging architecture offices: adn architectures, vincent p. alexis, Label architecture, LLAC architects, Radim Louda, Orthodoxe, SPECIMEN, VERS.A and V.O.
